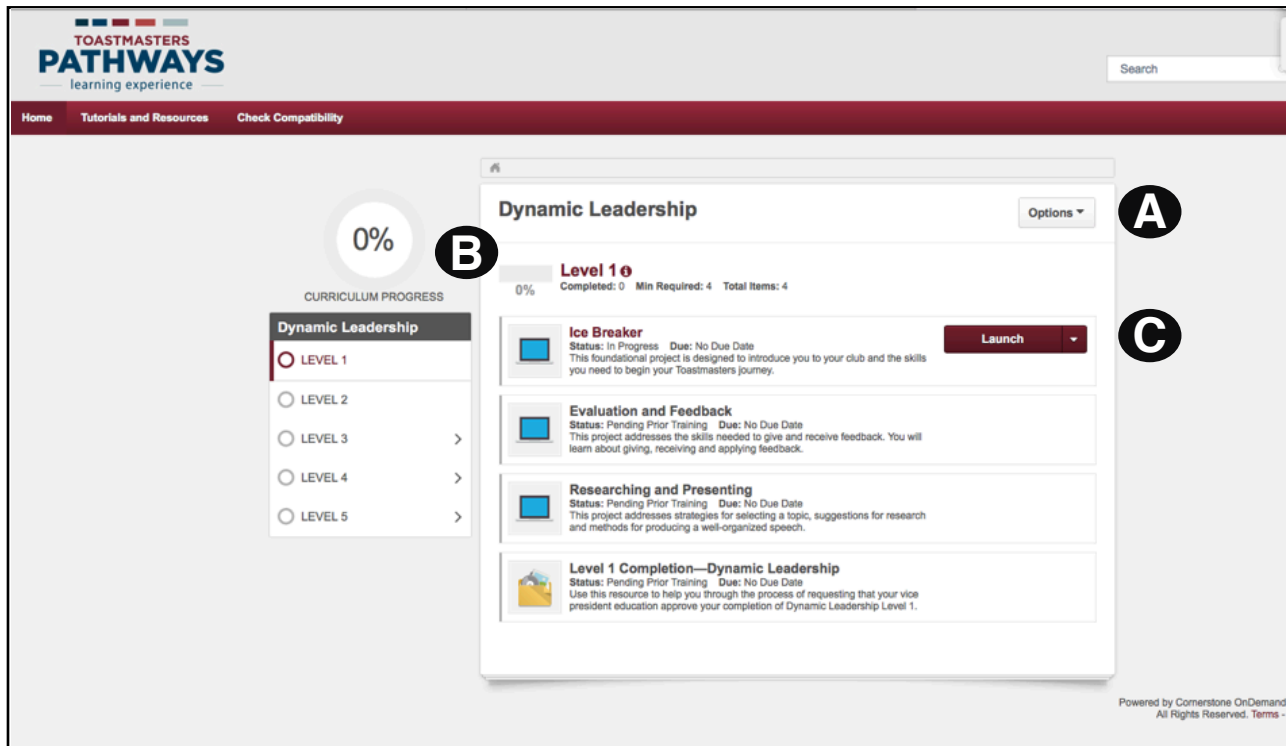
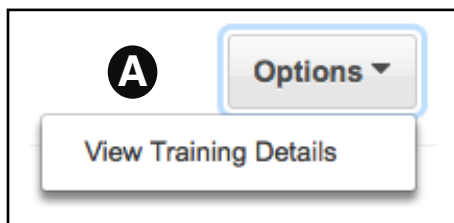


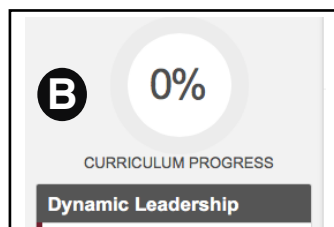

On this screen you can view details of your chosen path.



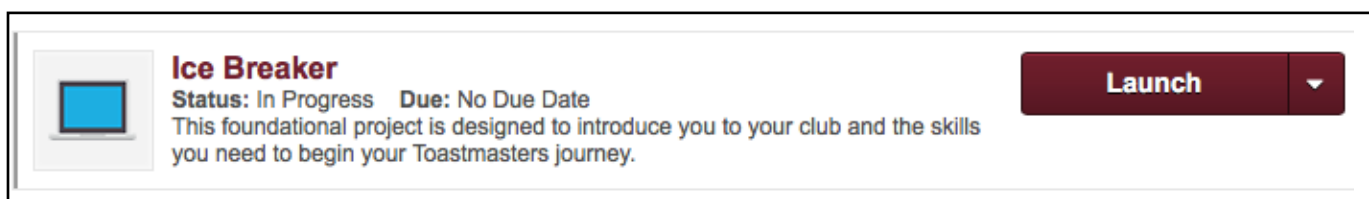
You can view details about all the projects in your path. Next to **Options** click the down arrow to reveal a menu. Click **View Training Details**.
