


2. Each project begins with a title page. Orient yourself to these instructions to complete your project. Select the **arrow B** at the bottom of the title page to reveal the menu.








- 3. **Navigation ©** provides instructions to:

Assess Your Skills—Before is how you can gauge your confidence as you work through each project.


5. click on a number to respond to each question on the screen. When you are finished, select **Submit**.
